SANDWICH — Robert Wayne "Coach" Kaminky, 88, of Sandwich, passed away Friday, Aug. 24, at Willow Crest Nursing Pavilion in Sandwich. He was a lifelong resident of Illinois and a resident of Sandwich for 50 years.

He was born May 16, 1924, in Sublette, to Erwin O. and Grace (Sargent) Kaminky. He grew up on the family farm outside of Earlville. He attended Earlville schools and joined the U.S. Army Air Forces in 1942.

Robert purchased a motor home and began touring the country with Marie. They toured much of the Western and Southwestern United States. They were married 35 years until she passed away in 1988.

He married Bernice (Petron) Neitzer in 1993, and began his second family, becoming stepfather to her three daughters,
